In **CELEBRITY MUGSHOT**, we'll take a comedic look at our favorite celebs not so glamorous photos taken by the people who we never want to run into at 1am: the cops. Whether it's Lindsay Lohan's dazed and confused look in her first of many famous shots or Tiger Woods' drug induced close up - most of these public figures fell from grace for one reason or another, so why not poke fun of it and see if and how they bounced back.

Mixing elements of *E! True Hollywood Story*, *Chelsea Lately* and *Girl Code*, **CELEBRITY MUGSHOT** will have a rotating, recurring group of comedians with a special guest "celebrity expert" and host recreating the stars criminal snapshot.

However, this is not solely a panel show. We will also cut from the studio to pre-recorded improvised recreations where our comedians will relive the moment that Justin Bieber cussed out a Miami police officer before showing off his pearly whites to all his Beliebers, Khloe pre-revenge body striking a side pose for the camera and Haley Joel Osment still trying to see a comeback for himself after his DUI at 18 years old.

The show will take place in front of a live audience that is reminiscent of your best friends living room during a sleepover, only with 50 more people.

Each half-hour, hosted episode will focus on three starlet's mug shots that are tied together by a theme such as: car crashes, shoplifting, sex crimes or protesting. Throughout the episode our host will be joined by a rotating panel of snarky comedians and a pop culture guest who is an expert in all things celebrity.
